<p><b>“Average” or 2 points</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Demonstrates average presentation skills consistent with his/her potential.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Demonstrates some understanding of the health/PE concept presented.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Presentation is somewhat organized and some of the audience find it interesting.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Presentation shows a little evidence of preparation and practiced delivery.</li> </ul>
<p><b>“Poor” or 1 point</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Demonstrates poor presentation skills consistent with his/her potential.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Demonstrates no understanding of the health/PE concept presented.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Presentation is not organized and isn't interesting to the audience.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Presentation shows no evidence of preparation and practiced delivery.</li> </ul>
